

Pick and Mix People

Contents:

36 cards which make 12 characters

Object

To be the first player to make three correctly matched characters.

To play

- Shuffle the cards on the table, character side down, and place them in a pile in the middle of the table.
- The youngest player begins by taking a card and placing it face upwards in front of them. Play then passes to the next player.
- Each player adds to their character until they have a mismatched head, body and legs card.
- If a player picks up a card and they already have that body part, they can choose to swap the body parts or keep the card they have. The remaining card should then be placed, face up, in the discard pile in the middle of the table.
- Following players can choose to pick up the top card from the discard pile or from the main pile.
- Once a whole character is collected, players can start to build a second character. (Players can only build 1 or 2 characters, and each player must have a mismatched 3 piece character before building a second character, at any time).
- Players can choose to move their cards from one of their characters to the other instead of taking their turn to pick from the piles.
- When a player has a correctly matched person, the set is moved to one side and play continues.
- If the cards in the main pile run out, the top card from the discard pile is left face upwards on the table and the cards are shuffled and returned to the middle of the table face downwards as the main pile.

The winner

The winner is the first player to make three correctly matched characters.
