

Round the Houses

Object

To be the first player to fill your removal van and to reach your new home in the centre of the board.

To play

- Each player chooses a coloured removal van and matching coloured small van counter.
- The board is assembled and in the centre the houses are placed on the matching colour sections.
- The small picture cards are spread face upwards on the table and each player then places their van counter on the matching coloured house, in the white spaces on the board where the house is up for sale.
- The youngest player begins by throwing the dice and moving their van the corresponding number of spaces in a clockwise direction around the outside edge of the board.
- On reaching an item, the player looks for the matching picture card and places it on their van. If the item has already been collected by another van, the player misses their go.
- If the player lands on a red space then they must return any one of their items to the table.
- If the player lands on a white space, where a house is up for sale, then they can choose any item from around the board (that has not already been taken) and place it on their own van.
- Play continues in a clockwise direction until a player has a full van, after this they must continue to move around the board until they reach the path which leads to their new house (matching the colour of their van) in the centre of the board.
N.B. Once a player has a full van, they no longer need to return an item if they land on a red space.
- Players continue to move along the path according to the numbers thrown on the dice. If a player lands on a roadworks space, then they miss their next turn.
- An exact number does not have to be thrown in order to reach their new house.

The winner

The winner is the first person to reach their new home.
