Stage Plot, Sound Setup, & Power Requirements



Stage Plot & Sound Setup

Large stage dimensions:

- * 20 feet wide
- * 16 feet deep

Regular stage dimensions:

- * 16 feet wide
- * 12 feet deep

Compact stage dimensions:

- * 11 feet wide
- * 10 feet deep

- 1 1 Vocal (lead)
1 Acoustic Guitar - plugged **Direct In**, amp used as monitor
- 2 1 Vocal
1 Electric Guitar
- 3 1 Vocal
1 Electric Bass
- 4 1 Vocal
1 Electric Guitar

- 5 4 piece drum kit - snare, rack tom, floor tom, bass drum. Hi-hat, ride cymbal, left crash, right crash
- 6 1 Vocal
2 Electric Keyboards - plugged **Direct In**, amp used as monitor
- 7 2 passive 15" speakers on stands
- 8 Amp setup from left to right: electric bass, keyboard electric guitar, acoustic guitar, electric guitar

- 9 2 wall outlets: 15-amp circuits
- 10 12 channel mixer + power amp
- 11 4 active floor monitors

Power Requirements

For power, we need the equivalent of two 15-amp circuits which is 1800 watts per circuit, which means we'd need about 3600 watts total.

Most residential and commercial circuits are 15 amp circuits. We use well under the 1800 watts per circuit (we actually use about 1200 watts total), however we prefer to run our equipment on two separate circuits to prevent overload.

In most cases, what this means is, we simply need two wall outlets that are on opposing walls (outlets on opposing walls are generally run on separate circuits).

We have plenty of extension cords if we need to run power from another far away location.
