Food & Catering Requirements

To ensure the comfort and performance readiness of all 11 members of *DCOM: Live*, the following food and beverage items are requested backstage upon arrival and available throughout the day for setup/soundcheck as well as before the show and during intermission:

General Dietary Note:

One band member has a severe seafood allergy. Please ensure no seafood is served or prepared in the same area.

Dinner:

- **Hot food or warm entrée** preferred if possible. (No vegetarian/vegan options needed)
- To be delivered/prepared at the end of soundcheck.

Snacks (available all day):

- A generous platter of **fresh cut vegetables** (carrots, celery, bell peppers, cucumbers, cherry tomatoes) with hummus and ranch dressing.
- Mixed nuts (unsalted and salted)
- Assorted protein or granola bars
- Crackers, pretzels, and popcorn
- Fresh whole fruit (bananas, apples, oranges, grapes)

Beverages:

- **At least 3 cases (36 bottles) of bottled water** (mix of room temp and chilled)
- A selection of **sparkling water** (e.g. LaCroix, Perrier)
- **Coffee setup** (brewed or single-serve, with dairy and non-dairy creamers, sugar, honey)
- Assorted **hot teas** (herbal and caffeinated), Throat Coat and honey preferred.
- Variety of **soft drinks** (Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite, etc.)
- Variety of **juices** (orange, apple, cranberry)
- **Plant-based milk options** (oat, almond, or soy)
