

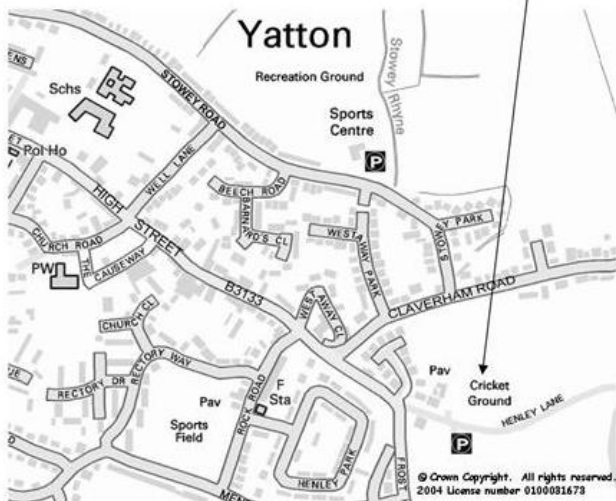

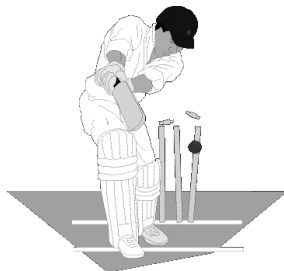

## CLUB PAY



At a recent Somerset meeting a recommendation was made that Club's should participate in the above scheme to receive online payments for items such as Membership Fees.

This has the effect of minimising the amount of cash which is handled within the Club and provides a clear and clean audit trail of the monies raised. It also means that the Club receives the money quicker as it hasn't spent time in the bottom of someone's kit bag!

The added advantage, from a data collection point of view, is that the players enter their personal details into the Club database themselves rather than someone else trying to decipher their handwriting! We hope that this will give us more accurate and complete data, something which we are required to keep in order to maintain our ClubMark.

## IMPROVEMENTS AROUND THE CLUB

You will no doubt be aware by now that the Club have been awarded £50,000 from the Inspired Facilities Fund of Sport England (SE). Plans have been drawn up to demolish Bomber's flood-prone garage and build a new one level with the front of the Clubhouse and to convert the existing Away Dressing Room into an Umpires' Room/Storage whilst building a new one along the back of the new garage. There will also be some improvements internally with the addition of another ladies loo and a disabled loo with baby changing facilities.



At this time the plans are with the Local Authority Planning Department awaiting planning permission. We hope there will be news soon.

At the other end of the ground there are currently two holes and a trench! This is soon to become the new scoreboard, remotely operated from the current scorebox and (at last!), clearly visible from all parts of the ground. The existing scorebox will be modified to give a better view of play for the scorers. This work is funded from the money left to us by Steve Alport in his will and carried out in his memory.

The new, wider, entrance has been finished and our thanks go to Mr and Mrs Jones who gave us the corner of her garden in order to achieve it. The work was prompted by access concerns raised by the Ambulance crew following an incident last season.

In addition to the grant for the clubhouse extension, we have just received a grant for £2800 from Sport England for two new sight-screens that should appear on the ground in June.

Following a review during the winter we have made significant savings on some of our out goings saving £189 a month on our rates, £18 a month on our telephone line and £62 a month on our electricity tariff.

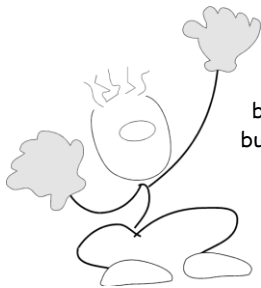

No special clothing is required, although logoed T-shirts are available for those that want them. All kit is provided.

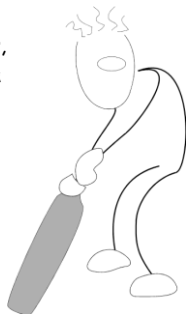
Sessions are run on the outfield and are split into Bronze, Silver and Gold according to age and experience.
