Like traditional meters, smart meters measure the amount of gas and electricity you use. A smart meter display shows you how much energy you are using and how much it will cost. This gives more control over your usage and helps you to save money. Your smart meter will send us your usage automatically, so you won't need to take meter readings.

The Government wants all homes and small businesses to have smart meters by 2020 so we can all improve energy efficiency.

We're aiming to install smart meters in our members' homes between 2016 and 2020.
