The whole project was a good and intense cultural experience, dealing with different backgrounds, expectations and ways of working from all the group members and also from our Indonesians partners, who were personally and deeply involved into the problem, made it even more challenging. Although all the differences in the pace and sense of urgency of each group member, I think through our good communication and mutual respect we were able to establish a common and efficient way of develop and conduct the project with professionalism. The facebook group gave us a good platform to share the content, articles and information about the subject and also was a good way to schedule meetings and discuss about the work being done in order to fit every requirement and deadlines. The only problem perceived for me was the lack of face-to-face interaction with Kartika, as we already learned in work psychology last period, some discussions and information sharing were not fully productive due to our facebook/skype way of communication and I missed the social interaction that we had only here, and also it was the main motive why we needed to meet sometimes the whole group and work together even

being in the same city; maybe the structure of the guidelines were a little bit confusing at the beginning, but Stephanie make it clear for us.

Finally, our partner helped us to keep the focus on the right information and the correct way to approach the problem with a perspective from who is right there (living and facing the problem daily), in a very active way, attending live in our meetings through the messenger, so our group were very grateful to all support provided. And personally, being part of a project like this make me more aware of all the possibilities to work as a WOP, especially in my case who changed from a marketing background because I was missing the purpose and the positive social impact that my job could have in other's people live, this collaboration make me more glad with my changing and focused on how is going to be my next steps, the need for a deep understanding of projects like Bulungula Incubator in South Africa and how to deal and apply it in other places like Indonesia and Brazil for instance.
