Goal

- Development of SpECTRE, an open-source community code for multiscale problems in astrophysics and gravitational-wave physics

Motivation

- Improved observational accuracy requires more accurate simulations
- Current codes don't scale to millions of cores

Key Innovations

- Discontinuous Galerkin (DG) for discretization
- Task-based parallelism
