

Privacy

Each party warrants to the other party that:

any Personal Information that that party discloses to the other party under this Agreement has been collected in accordance with Privacy Laws;

the individual to whom the Personal Information relates has been made aware of the identity of the other party and of the other matters of which that party is required to inform the person about whom it collects information; and

the disclosure of that Personal Information to, and its use by, the other party and its personnel under or in connection with this Agreement is authorised by or under the Privacy Law.

Each party will immediately inform the other of any suspected or actual data or privacy breaches or intrusions of any nature that might impact the other party and each party will fully co-operate with the other in the mitigation, management and disclosure of any such breach or intrusion. Without limiting the foregoing, each party must notify the other party of any actual, threatened or potential security or privacy breaches within a reasonable time of it coming to that party's knowledge or the knowledge of any of its personnel or sub-contractors and will:

take all steps reasonably required to minimise the impact of the breach;

take such action as the other party may require (acting reasonably) to resolve the breach and rectify the cause of the breach; and

use its best endeavours to ensure no further breach of that nature occurs.

Each party acknowledges and agrees that the other party will deal with any notification obligations imposed under the GDPR in relation to a notice received in relation to any actual, threatened or potential security or privacy breaches regarding that party's data.
