



- ► Develop critical thinking by asking key questions about the environment and analysing landscapes and ecosystems.

THE LEGEND OF MAUL SEAND THE RESOURCE TOTEM

must follow to protect natural



We analyse how we currently use natural resources and introduce new materials and alternatives to minimise the production of waste by reusing it in a sustainable manner.

The workshop takes place in an exotic and inspiring environment, the Polynesia beach, where we reflect on the social and natural factors that affect the environment and its biodiversity.

We promote responsible consumption and delve into individual behaviours that affect the sustainability of our planet. This is all done in a dynamic

and participatory way, helping to build relationships between classmates.

Our ecologist and explorer will lead the workshop and challenge the class to rebuild the Resource Totem.

Working together as a group, they will carry out various tasks. Through a playful and educational format, the pupils will learn the key concepts of environmental sustainability and will then take a proactive role in reflecting on the knowledge that they have acquired.

In this workshop, the class will develop teamwork, critical thinking, and creative problem solving, among other skills. At the end, they will be able to draw relevant conclusions about the need for proper waste management to preserve biodiversity and guarantee the future of the planet.

- Promote the observation and assessment of the natural environment through the analysis of different ecosystems, comparing the native biodiversity with that of other places in the world.
- Connect the structure of animals and plants with their vital functions and their survival. Understand how environmental factors affect them: climate, food, human activities, etc.
- ► Define responsible consumption habits and actions that help to protect biodiversity and encourage long-term sustainable behaviours.

THE LEGEND STATE OF WHANAU

The Biodiversity workshop is inspired by Māori culture, where family is a much broader and richer concept than the one we understand. For them, all living beings (animals, insects, plants...) and the natural environment (mountains, rivers, seas...) come together to form Whanau, "the extended family", which we must preserve and protect.





This workshop begins with a tour of the Makumanu Garden, located in the Polynesia area. There, we observe the flora and learn about its importance in the natural life cycle.

In the Makumanu Show space, pupils meet the various species of exotic birds that live in

the park. We finish with a group discussion to reflect on what has been learned and reinforce sustainable habits.









A biologist specialising in birds will present and teach the class the morphology and habits of different species. Through a fun activity that will require them to use their observational skills, pupils will work together to identify different varieties of plants. They will learn about exotic birds such as macaws (among others), their main characteristics and differences, their diet, their natural habitat, etc.

Guided by our specialists, the group dynamics foster participation and strengthen personal relationships between pupils. They also help to raise awareness and encourage commitment to the protection of the environment.



By plane

Reus airport is the closest. A direct bus service will bring you to PortAventura World in just 10 minutes.

Barcelona airport is only an hour away and offers a bus service to bring you to our hotels.

By train

By high-speed train (AVE)

The Camp de Tarragona AVE station is just 20 minutes from PortAventura World.

By car or coach

- Via the AP-7 motorway coming from La Jonquera or the south of Spain: exit 35 leads directly to PortAventura World.
- ▶ Via the **C-32**, from Barcelona or El Vendrell: join the **AP-7**.
- ► Via the AP-2, from the Basque Country or Zaragoza: join the AP-7.
