

OUR ESG STRATEGY

Environmental, social and good governance sustainability. These are the 3 main strategies set out by the ESG integrated plan for one of the top leisure resorts in Europe: PortAventura World. A success model that shares the principles covered in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) promoted by the United Nations and in the commitment to the UNWTO Global Code of Ethics for Tourism.

Certified Corporation

The resort's sustainability strategy is based on boosting and encouraging environmental initiatives that promote care for the environment. An example of this is its recognition as Europe's first carbon neutral resort in 2020. In 2022, we extended the calculation of our carbon footprint in scope 3 emissions to, in turn, promote actions to reduce these emissions. In addition, in 2023 PortAventura became the first resort in the world to receive BCorp certification.



A sustainability strategy transformed into a global reference model















The resort's strategic commitment to sustainability has become an international benchmark for the theme park industry in Europe, the Middle East and Africa (EMEA), both in terms of leadership, innovation and vision for the future. So much so that in 2021 the company was awarded the IAAPA EMEA Award for Extraordinary Efforts, the first and only award of its kind from the global leisure and entertainment industry (IAAPA).

Looking ahead to 2032, the resort has also joined the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi), a collaboration between the non-profit organisation CDP, the UN Global Compact, the World Resources Institute (WRI) and the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF), which supports organisations when it comes to setting emissions reduction targets of up to 55% to keep global warming at no more than 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels.

Alongside this, the company is also driving other environmental initiatives aimed at water conservation and reuse, such as the installation of low-consumption equipment for heating water in hotel rooms. Currently, and since 2016, 100% of the resort's electricity comes from carbon-free renewable sources and, in 2021, the resort obtained the AENOR Zero Waste certification, which recognises its traceability system in waste management, with an annual reuse rate of over 90%, thus preventing it from ending up in landfill and promoting sustainability through the circular economy.

In this regard, 93% of single-use plastics in the resort's restaurants were eliminated or replaced in 2021 alone, while the water rides are powered by a specially designed underground rainwater harvesting system. Furthermore, the company's support for local suppliers is a priority.

In order to reduce and control its emissions, the resort is backing the use of cleaner modes of transport by developing one of the largest electric car charging hubs in Europe. All in all, the complex has a huge electric charging infrastructure with 150 free charging points for visitors and employees in total; this is ahead of the regulations that will oblige public car parks to have at least one charging point for every 40 spaces as of 2023.

The most recent initiative announced by the company was that of obtaining the licence for the construction of

the biggest self-consumption photovoltaic plant at a holiday resort in Spain and one of the biggest in Europe: PortAventura Solar. This is a project which saw the installation of more than 11,000 photovoltaic modules on a surface area spanning 6.4 hectares, generating 10 GWh/year of clean electricity to cover almost a third of the total energy required by the resort to operate. The construction is located on land owned by PortAventura World, and is part of a plan to be respectfully integrated with the landscape and to create a space for educating about the environment. The project also has a second construction phase that is already underway, which will have a capacity of 3.1 megawatt peaks (MWp) and will provide 5.6 GWh more per year. The installation of the plant has involved a total investment of more than 8 million euros.

POLYNESIA

Polynesia exudes realism in each and every aspect. The entire pathway is surrounded by streams that flow over volcanic rocks, making the visitor feel like they are in a tropical paradise with fun attractions and exotic shows.

The main rides in Polynesia are Tutuki Splash, wagons that drop rapidly from the summit of the volcano down to the lake, and the Kontiki canoes that navigate the Polynesian islands on the tumultuous sea waves.

These strange sculptures, which visitors will come across as they make their way through Polynesia, are divinities brought over from the Fiji and Tonga islands.







CHINA



In China visitors enter the farming town of Ximpang where, in the higher parts, they will see the Emperor's summer residence: a recreation of the "Forbidden City" of Beijing, where visitors may also find a replica of the Great Wall.

The attractions in this area are among the most striking in PortAventura Park. In addition to Shambhala, visitors can enjoy the famous Dragon Khan, one of the most iconic attractions in the park. For the most daring, this roller coaster has 8 loop-the-loops, reaching zero gravity through a "corkscrew" effect and with a dizzying drop from 45 metres high at speeds of up to 100 km/h.

At the heart of Ferrari Land, we find the main building, Ferrari Experience, where visitors can become immersed in the world of the Italian motor racing team. Inside there is Ferrari Gallery, an impressive space in the form of the silhouette of the legendary LaFerrari model, where visitors can enjoy an interactive tour and learn about the

story of the brand.

Without a doubt, the vertical accelerator **Red Force** is the park's star attraction. Its svelte form is visible from several kilometres away and has become part of the skyline of PortAventura World. With an acceleration that can reach 180 km/hour in only 5 seconds and a height of 112 metres, it is truly an incredible experience for all lovers of speed and Formula 1^{TM} .

Another of the most powerful attractions in the park are the **Thrill Towers**, two free fall and bounce-back towers that resemble giant pistons of a Formula 1^{TM} car. Each tower has its own characteristics and offers different experiences to those who dare to try them.

Ferrari Land gives its visitors the option to step into the shoes of a professional driver. For this, the park has 8 amazing simulators in **Pole Position**Challenge, where visitors can test their expertise as drivers. These simulators are very similar to the same ones used by professional F1 ™ drivers during training. In addition, in the park's Pit Stop, visitors will experience first-hand the rush of adrenaline felt by Formula 1™ mechanics as they compete to be the fastest in changing the wheels of a true-to-scale race car.

THE PERFECT PLACE FOR AN ADRENALINE-FILLED ADVENTURE

Visitors can also enjoy the race circuit **Maranello Grand Race** a journey in one of the Italian firm's GT racing cars, along a track of over 500 metres, where they will experience the excitement of driving a scale reproduction of a Ferrari.

There is also a Kids' Area in the park for the little ones. This space features five attractions suitable for children, that still embody the true spirit of the Italian motor racing team. Junior Red Force is a mini version of the iconic Red Force roller coaster that allows children to feel the same speed sensations as experienced on the vertical accelerator. There is also **Kids'** Tower, a 9 m free fall and bounce-back tower and Crazy Pistons, a ride inspired by the movement of the pistons in a Ferrari engine. Alongside these, visitors can enjoy two other attractions: Champions Race to see what it feels like behind the wheel of a legendary Ferrari Testarossa 250, and Flying Race, the perfect attraction for budding young drivers.

In addition, on **Junior Championship**, it is possible to climb on board a miniature reproduction of a Formula 1 TM car and experience all the excitement of drifting in an attraction inspired by the traditional "whip".

The park has six restaurants: from the traditional **Ristorante Cavallino**, based on the restaurant in Maranello (home of Ferrari), where you can soak up the history of the brand of the Cavallino Rampante to a themed fast food outlet **Pit Lane**, inspired by the legends of the Ferrari drivers. And of course, there are also several Italian ice cream parlours.



With this new gastronomic project, PortAventura World has shown, yet again, its commitment to innovation and to guaranteeing wonderful moments









Reflecting the Mediterranean light and architecture, this hotel has been designed with rooms that are distributed in buildings of no more than three floors located around a central area of swimming pools, gardens, and terraces. The hotel also has direct access to the park's Mediterrania area and to the PortAventura World Convention Centre, which makes it very convenient for anyone who wants to fully enjoy the attractions and shows of PortAventura Park.

In the early 1800s, a story ran through the Wild West: a young woman named Lucy Callaghan had found gold in a stream near the Gold River. This finding changed the lives of hundreds of families. Times had been hard for them, so they decided to pool their first riches to build a hotel full of comforts where they felt truly privileged.

This hotel has 150 Colorado Deluxe rooms with all kinds of details in the hotel's main building. There are also 141 Colorado Creek Valley Superior rooms and 21 River Bungalow cabins surrounded by trees. The theme is inspired by the gold rush era of the Wild West and continues to delve into the history of the hotel complex comprising the Gold River Hotel, The Callaghan's Hotel and Lucy's Mansion Hotel.

Its services include a spacious restaurant, exclusive car park and swimming pool with the Lake Bar restaurant area.

Inspired by the Victorian splendour of the late 19th century, Hotel Gold Ri-ver invites guests to journey back in time and stay a while in Sullivan Village, a small town founded in 1803 by Lucy Callaghan after discovering golden nuggets along the river where she and her family were resting on their way to Santa Fe. This discovery led them to become the founders of the town of Sullivan, where families and pilgrims began to settle and prosper thanks to the Gold Mine: Callaghan's Mining Company.

The hotel has three river-shaped swimming pools, three restaurants and activities for both day and night. The Callaghan's Building is also part of the Hotel Gold River complex. This annexe has 78 superior category rooms as well as its own reception, separate from the Hotel Gold River reception. It has direct access to PortAventura Park through the Far West area.

As part of the strategic commitment to expand the hotel offer and promote a new management model, in mid-2022, PortAventura World announced the acquisition and management of the Atenea Aventura Hotel, the first hotel accommodation outside the resort's current perimeter. Located in the town of Vila-Seca, the four-star Atenea Aventura Hotel has 94 standard rooms and apartments, which will reinforce the resort's hotel offer for the corporate events public who attend the PortAventura Convention Centre throughout the year.

The transaction, which is part of the resort's strategy of innovation and diversification, represents PortAventura World breaking into a new model of hotel management, extending its borders within the Costa Dorada and allowing it to intensify the growth of the resort's accommodation offer. This action was the first of a series of selective transactions that the company plans to make in other hotels in the area to boost its inorganic growth.

Within the framework of this agreement, this year will see the launch of a new version of the video game created by PortAventuraWorld and LaLiga, with the aim of making the virtual game, once again, a benchmark in new digital entertainment.









LaLiga TwentyNine's is the **first completely LaLiga-themed restaurant in the world** with a surface area of 1,000m² and capacity for more than 400 people; it is an innovative space that will turn sports broadcasts into a unique and differential experience. The restaurant is also the first in the resort to be LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) certified, the most renowned international recognition for sustainable buildings.

Inspired by the year that football as a competition was founded in Spain (1929), the restaurant offers a **first-of-its-kind sports bar**concept where you can enjoy a **quality culinary experience** combined with the highest level of **live sporting competitions**

LaLiga TwentyNine's recreates different spaces and atmospheres that invite you to immerse yourself in the world of LaLiga. There is a **grandstand area** where you can enjoy live sports broadcasts, as well as an **eSports Arena** area, which gives you the chance to play FIFA22 on the PS5 and enjoy an Augmented Reality experience.

Visitors can also enjoy the **photopportunity area**, which allows them to take a souvenir photo with the LaLiga cup or with the shirt of their favourite LaLiga Santander team, as well as the **memorabilia area**, where they can take a look at various collector's items.

PortAventura World also offers a unique convention centre, a benchmark throughout Europe, with the capacity to hold any type of event. The PortAventura Business & Events Convention **Centre** has ample and versatile spaces in a **structure that is** completely integrated into the Mediterranean setting and has been designed with particular attention to sustainability and respect for the environment.

Amongst other assets, the building benefits from natural light in most of its rooms and in its management the saving, recycling and reuse of water and energy resources have been prioritised. The building is fully accessible to people with disabilities.

The convention centre spans 20,000 m2, has 24 halls and can afford a maximum capacity of 6,000 people in total. The expansion resulted in the new Roma room, divisible into three spaces, with a total area of 2,110 m2 and with the capacity to accommodate more than 2,000 people. The space is fully integrated into the landscape, has natural light, large terraces, in addition to unbeatable views of the sea. The expansion also includes a large kitchen fitted with the latest equipment. There are another three rooms with total capacity for more than 1,300 people. ideal for any type of function such as talks, large gatherings, meetings of boards of directors or executive committees.

PortAventura Business & Events (one hour from Barcelona) is well-connected to the main international airports via the AVE (Renfe) train network, and also to the rest of the resort and its hotels, particularly Hotel PortAventura to which it has direct and exclusive access.

The PortAventura Foundation, is the entity that channels and promotes all of PortAventura World's social actions that make up its corporate responsibility policy. Since 2011, the Foundation has worked with **1,445 related organisations** and has given out **aid to the value of 8,867,369 Euros** through numerous projects. In addition, over these years, more than **70,000 children and young people** at risk of exclusion due to health problems, disability or financial problems have benefited from the various programmes.

Its activities focus on four areas of action: charity days in PortAventura Park to raise awareness amongst visitors and raise funds for other organisations, own fundraising events to promote charity projects, accessibility to leisure and direct contributions to projects. In 2014, PortAventura Foundation donated 3 million Euros to the **Sant Joan de Déu Hospital** to fund the construction of the **hospital's new paediatric ICU**, that has been up and running since 2018.

The implementation of the project **PortAventura Dreams**, launched in 2019, is one more step in the Foundation's commitment to contribute real value to society and its environment. It is a physical space, different and playful, but also an emotional space, designed to exert a positive psychological effect during the fight against the disease, whilst encouraging and nurturing new moments of family togetherness. **The initiative, a ground-breaking scheme in Europe**, is the result of **an investment**

The initiative, a ground-breaking scheme in Europe, is the result of an investment of more than 4 million Euros.

PortAventura Dreams welcomes families with children and young people living with serious illnesses from all over Spain in a unique space of 8,850 $m_{\rm 2}$, where they can enjoy a free six-day stay together full of excitement and family activities. In total, they make up around 200 families each year and **since its inauguration it has welcomed 350 families (1,669 people)**. The village has six houses of 135 $m_{\rm 2}$, play area, football pitch and gardens that surround the entire environment, an exclusive family restaurant for guests and a multi-purpose room. The package, in addition to the accommodation in the villas, includes access to the parks of PortAventura World.

By the end of 2023, the PortAventura Dreams Foundation will continue to grow with 4 new family homes that will increase the village's capacity to house up to 340 families throughout the year. Part of this new construction will be made possible thanks to the sponsorship from Fundació La Caixa and Trans Gourmet.

In order to develop this initiative, the PortAventura Foundation is supported by a network of partners: private companies, other foundations and, mainly, leading hospitals in Spain such as the Niño Jesús de Madrid University Children's Hospital, Sant Joan de Déu Hospital and Vall d'Hebron Hospital, together with the Red Cross. The project is also supported by founding donors whose contributions have made PortAventura Dreams a reality: El Corte Inglés, Barça Foundation, Cruyff Foundation, "la Caixa" Foundation, LaLiga Foundation, Probitas Foundation, LG, Mango and Mediapro.

The project continues to grow with a pioneering psychological study by Vall d'Hebron Hospital, which aims to look for scientific evidence on the benefits of leisure for health and wellbeing.
