



Remote Learning

At Hambrook Primary School

This poster aims to signpost **parents** in the direction of the appropriate support that has been put in place for Remote Learning to take place should your child(ren) have to self-isolate.

Scenario 1:

Your child cannot attend school due to self-isolation or they are awaiting test results. The rest of the their class remains in school however

- Work will be uploaded here at the start of each term to allow individuals self isolating at home to access a range of age appropriate activities if they are well enough to do so.

Scenario 2:

A bubble of children have to be sent home to self-isolate including your child(ren).

- Your child will be self-isolating at home
- **Your child can refer to the Day 1 activities posted on the website and the Hambrook Remote Learning Drive for their 1st day in isolation**
- Your child's teacher will deliver lessons via pre-recorded videos that can be accessed using Google Classroom and your child's
- Hambrook Google Account (login details in their reading records)
- All children can watch lessons at home and carry out tasks or any other activities posted by their teacher on their class Google Drive within their virtual classroom
- Children can also submit their work on Google Classroom for their teacher to look at

All teachers recording lessons will do their absolute best to prepare tasks that require **ONLY** plain paper and a pencil instead of lots of printing.

Each day, teachers will be uploading:

- A pre-recorded Maths Lesson (KS1-10mins / KS2- 20mins)
- A pre-recorded English Lesson (Grammar or writing)
- Reading or Phonics Activity
- Topic Activity

Scenario 3:

A bubble of children including your child can continue to attend school but their teacher cannot due to self-isolating or they are awaiting test results.

- Children will attend school as normal
- Their teacher (if well enough) will deliver live lessons from home through Google Classroom
- Your child's class will always have a adult in class whilst this is happening.
