We welcome Miss Millington after the Easter break who will be Year 1's teacher.

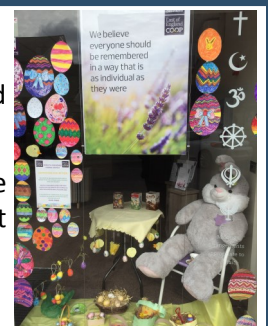
## Absence
