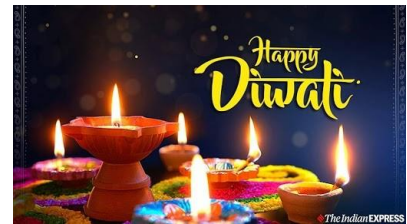

Wow...thank you! We had a fantastic spotty day at the nursery in support of Children in Need.

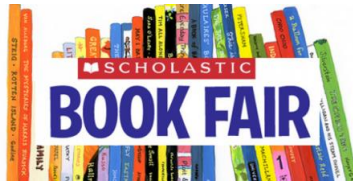
