Tuesday Dean Davis - Met Police to talk to Year 6 9.30am on knife crime

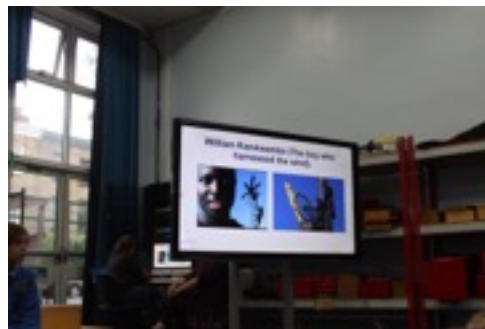
Wednesday Year 4 assembly 9.15am all welcome to attend. + Book Fair leaves.
