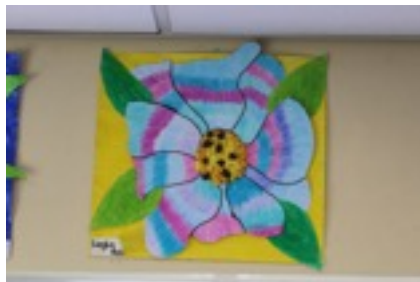
SATS week Year 6 all week Monday to Thursday and then Friday it's whoopee day !! Prayers for Year 6 !!
