Agenda: To consider how we could improve playtimes for all children and the equipment that we think might help to make playtimes more enjoyable for all pupils.

#### Ideas brought by the School Council Reps:

- To repair the buddy bench or consider new ways to provide pupils with a place to go to find a friend.
- Pupils thought that a way to encourage improved playtime behaviour could be by having a 'best behaved child of the week' for each class with rewards.
- Rules for the Trim Trail could be implemented – such as 'no overtaking other children.'
- New pens for the large outdoor whiteboard to be provided.
- Could teams playing a game of football be allowed to borrow either different coloured team bibs or bands so that they can easily see which children belong to which team.
- School council reps brought along many ideas for new equipment that could be purchased to make playtimes even more enjoyable.
- Pupils would like a quiet section of the playground to be created to enable those children who would like a calmer, quieter playtime to have somewhere to go to.
- Possible creation of a 'make your own bug house' area or birdwatching area with RSPB birds poster/ binoculars/ bird feeders etc.
- Pupils suggested possible creation of a bottle flipping station.
- Possible creation of a 'hook a number' using quoits game.
- Pupils suggested a small stage with music playing and pompoms.

### Actions:

- Mrs Luebcke to order new School Council Badges for all new School Council representatives.
- New pens for the large outdoor whiteboard to be provided.
- Mrs Luebcke to discuss ideas and equipment suggested with Mrs How and Class Teachers.
- Mrs Luebcke to discuss the creation of a quiet area of the playground with Mrs How and Class Teachers.
