Amount of Grant received is £9,800 for 2016-2017

At St Mary's R.C. School we decided to use this money to

- Buy into Poole and East Dorset Schools Sports Association.
- Provide Sports Leader non-contact time to continue to develop an effective PE curriculum and provide high quality teaching from teachers and specialists.
- Buy better P.E. equipment including new football goals, gymnastic mats, balls, pumps, table tennis equipment.
- Pay for Planet Education coaches to provide CPD lessons in addition to after school Sports Clubs.
- Pay for visiting specialists to offer our children other sporting activities including street-dancing, pilates and tennis.
- Released staff to attend PE Conferences
- Development of an orienteering course to enable the children to undertake orienteering activities.
- Subsidised the cost of a residential visit to PGL in Weymouth for our Year 6 pupils.
- Paid for staff to run after school sports clubs, e.g. netball, cross country.

Targets for 2016-2017

- Improve the current curriculum provision across the whole school.
- To develop additional opportunities in P.E. and sport related activities that children may not have experienced before.
- Develop more confident staff delivering high quality PE lessons.
- Enhance the extra-curricular provision.
- Increased pupil participation in competitive activities.
- Develop sports leader roles within the life of the school.
- Provide Pupil Premium children the opportunity to have additional experiences.
- Introduce an assessment scheme across the whole school for ensuring attainment and progress.

Impact measures

- The development of core skills in EYFS, Key Stage 1 and 2.
- Better quality teaching across the school.
- An increase in the number of pupils taking part in extra curricular activities.
- An increase in participation rates in all P.E. and Games lessons.
- Greater success in competitive school sports.
