## **ADVENT – 'POSASA' AT ST MARY'S**

This Advent we are again undertaking a Mexican Tradition that is becoming popular in some church communities. 'Posada' is a Spanish word meaning 'Inn'. In Mexico two young people used to travel from house to house telling people about the imminent arrival of Jesus and asking if they would give Him a room.

The modern day equivalent is based on this concept but encourages people to give a home to the figures of Mary and Joseph for a night. This symbolises making room for Jesus in our lives, homes and communities. The journey encourages us to think about the meaning of Christmas and to share the message with others.

Each night during Advent the figures will travel around the parish, work place or community, arriving back at church on Christmas Eve in time to celebrate the birth of Jesus.

Posada has become an important outreach tool in some places with the figures going into schools, old people's homes and hospitals, last year ours even spent a night in a hotel reception! They will be accompanied by a prayer card which can be read on transfer to their next 'home' for the night. Historically parishes have asked parishioners to 'register' their families as members of the parish. The details typically recorded are names, address, telephone number; we may have an email address. These details are then recorded on a card system or computer database and have been kept indefinitely. They are used for pastoral reasons, e.g. for a priest to visit you should you be sick.
