To research the process of mummification academically and practically. Describe the social, cultural and religious aspects of ancient Egyptian society. Research the discovery of a famous tomb and record using notes .



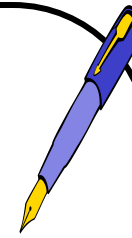
Literacy
