

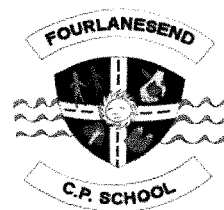

**We meet every other Saturday: next meet is tomorrow, Saturday 8th May 2-4.30pm.**
