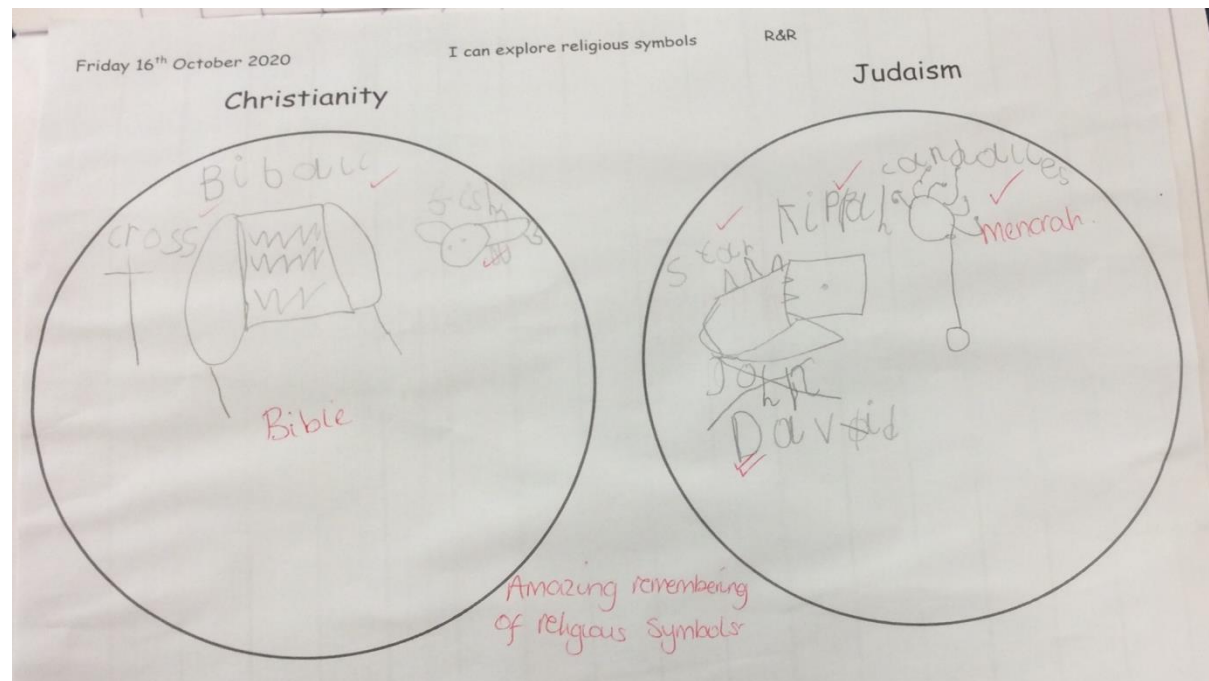

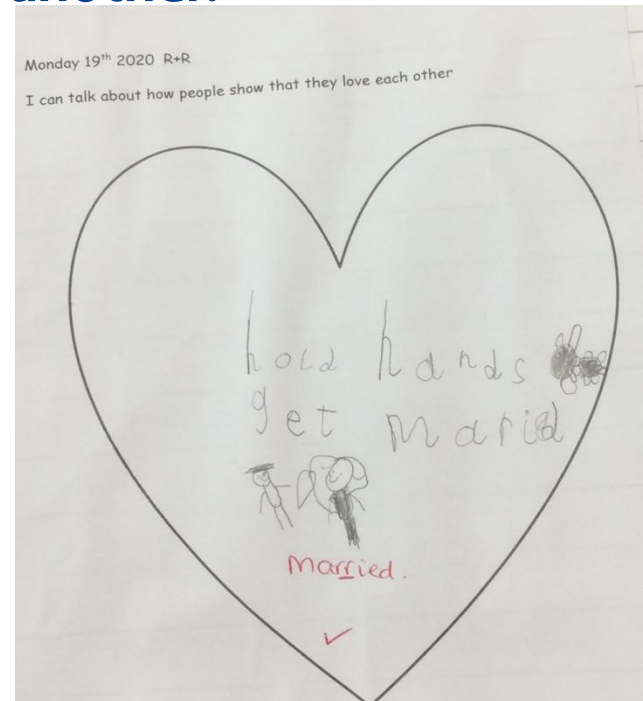
Religious Symbols
