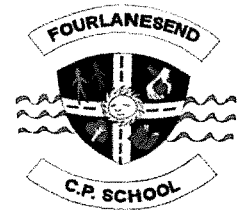

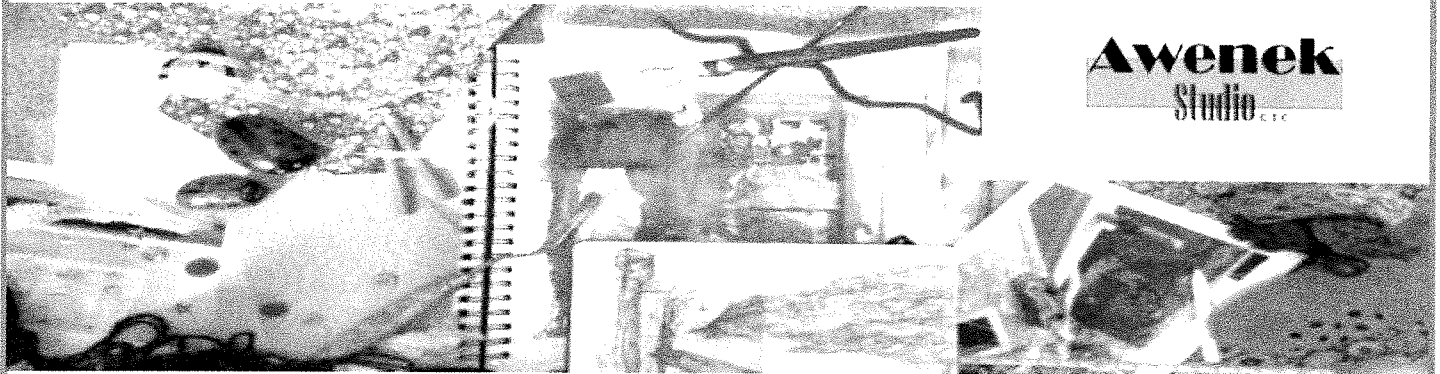

Foundation for Infant Loss

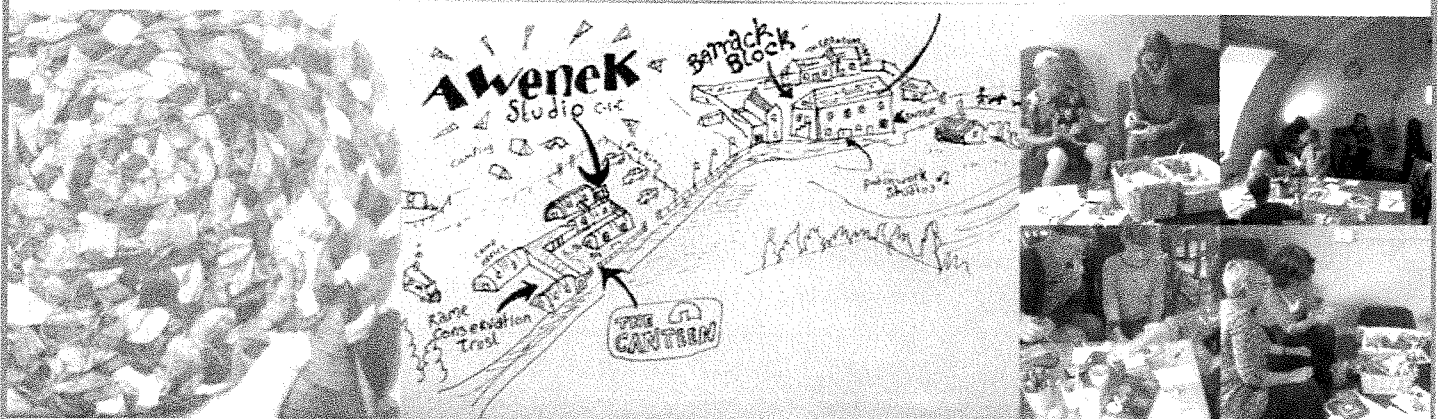
