

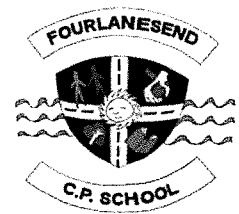

Reminder - children who have just moved up from Year 2 (Cremyll) to Year 3 (Tamar), now have to pay for school dinners. If you think you may be entitled to free school meals, please ask for a form at the office or apply online (www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolmeals). Also, if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and you think you would be eligible for free school meals, regardless of the Universal Free School Meals Scheme, please apply online/ask at the office as the school receives vital funding for your children.
