

School Council Meeting 18th May -

Attending: Kathy, Marley, Rosie, Ella, Eddie, Brae, Hannah, Jack and Ruby.

Actions from previous meeting:

1) Fill a Jar ACTION - School Council to send out fliers with information about this. - Completed £181 raised. Feedback from the event: Very positive feedback from everyone and improved contents in the jars.

2) ACTION - School Council to ask Mrs Champion about sports equipment for playtime and lunchtime use (idea - Ellie W) Mrs Champion has purchased a large bag of equipment for this purpose with the money raised from the Antony James visit.

3) ACTION - School Council to discuss how to spend money raised for the playground with Mrs Dennehy - this is still outstanding.

4) ACTION - hole in the fence - to be mended by our handyman. RN spoken to Steve. Children reported nobody could get out and they didn't see it as a problem.

5) ACTION: Y6 members of the school council to liaise with Mrs Champion and Mrs Parsonage to find out and report back how much money was raised for Sports Relief -£262.20 was raised

Issues raised:

- 1) Sports Tops from the money raised from Fill a jar - the council discussed the requirements - royal blue, NOT polo shirts or long sleeve and sports fabric not T shirt material (jersey fabric) and the school logo on. Examples were looked at on the internet. **ACTION - RN to find examples and to check with the school council before ordering.**
- 2) As discussed in pupil voice assembly, a suggestion box needs putting out with the school council display. **ACTION - School Council to see Mr Wilde who may have one and then to put it out and remind children about it in pupil voice assembly.**
- 3) Several members of the school council raised the issue of netball as they thought they may have a match. **ACTION - School Council to speak to Mrs Champion.**

4) Sports day is planned for Friday 27th May. The school council would like to arrange a raffle as they felt parents liked this and it would raised some money for the council. They are going to ask for prizes on the school newsletter.
