

**English/Literacy/Communication and Language (SMSC)**

Y1 Children will:

- Write postcards and create posters.
- Learn to write a simple sentence, including full stops, capital letters and checking it makes sense.

Y2 Children will be:

- Asking questions and collecting facts about animals.
- Writing instructions using complex sentences.

FS Children will be learning to write simple sounds in phonics and their own names correctly.

**Maths**

Y1 &2 Children will be:

- Learning place value between 1-100, including one more and one less and counting forwards and backwards.
- Learning to read and write numbers in numerals and words.
- Representing and using number bonds.
- Ordering and comparing numbers.
- Addition and subtraction.

FS Children will be:

- Learning to count, recognise and order numbers.
- Identify and describe shapes.
- Recognise coins and their value in our seaside shop.

**Science/Understanding the World (SMSC)**

Y1 & 2 Children will be:

- Developing their understanding of plants and their structure.
- Learning to identify common garden plants and wild plants.
- Observing and describing seasonal changes.

FS Children will be:

- Looking at life by the sea and the role of a fisherman.

**PE/Physical Development (SMSC, MB)**

Children will be:

- Learning a variety of gymnastic shapes as well as learning how to use equipment.
- They will also learn how to control their bodies while travelling.

**Computing/Personal, Social and Emotional Development (SMSC, MB)**

Children will be:

- Learning how to stay safe online.
- Learning how to use an app or complete a simple program on the iPad.
- Investigating our core emotions.
- Finding out about ourselves.

- Comparing our local area to Cornish moorland (FS, Y1).
- Learning about different aspects of tourism in Cornwall (Y2).
