

English (SMSC)

Y1 & 2 Children will be:

- Creating list poems to describe how something makes them feel
- Learning about different types of words and how we use them in sentences
- Giving reasons for why characters feel a certain way
- Creating story maps and stories
- Learning about non-fiction texts
- Explaining our understanding of what we read

Maths

Y1 & 2 Children will be:

- Sorting objects into different categories.
- Ordering and comparing numbers.
- Learning place value between 1- 20 extending to 1-100, including finding one more and one less as well as counting forwards and backwards.
- Learning to read and write numbers in numerals and words.
- Representing and using number bonds.
- Addition and subtraction.

Science (SMSC)

Y1 & 2 Children will be:

- Identifying wild animals
- Understanding habitats
- Finding out how they get their prey and how that links to food chains
- Classifying animals as herbivores, omnivores and carnivores
- Observing and describing seasonal changes and weather forecasting

PE (SMSC, MB)

Children will be:

- Learning the principles of invasion games such as attacking, defending, scoring and teamwork
- Taking part in a range of individual, paired and team games

- Learning to work cooperatively

Geography (MB. SMSC)

Children will be:

Children will be:

- Investigating hot and cold colours
- Creating tints and developing rules for colour mixing
- Learning about Paul Klee and his use of colour

- Exploring the world around us to help us learn about God
- Investigating Old Testament stories to learn about God and his creation
