1 to 1 support for children with SEN	Teaching Assistant support to deliver Individual Support Plan interventions to aid learning and progress.	£13,787	Through termly pupil progress meetings and Teacher Assessment data. Pupils to make at least expected progress.
Speech & Language Support	Speech and Language support to aid communication and language ability, using both Wellcomm and Talk Boost programmes.	£1,859	Through termly pupil progress meetings and Teacher Assessment data.
TA to support pupils' social & emotional development.	1 to 1 and/or group sessions to improve behaviour, social interactions and mental health/wellbeing, including Protected Behaviours intervention.	£3,738	Improved behaviour for learning observed by staff.
