Summer

CORE SUBJECTS

Maths



In Maths we are going to consolidate our work on times tables and learning more about multiplication and division.

We will be making sure we have a secure understanding of the four main operations, in preparation for Year Three.

We will be beginning some work on Fractions, as well as looking at how to tell the time.

Any practise at home of telling the time would be really beneficial.

English



During our English lessons, we will be looking at Fairy Tales, starting with Little Red Riding Hood.

We will be doing some writing linked to our topic and The Great Fire of London.

We will really be focusing on making sure our handwriting is neat and clear, with our letters sitting on the lines. We will be making sure we are remembering all our full stops and capital letters.

Science



In Science, we will start off by looking at Habitats. We will be naming some of the different habitats, as well as thinking about why certain animals are suited to them.

We will also be going over materials, thinking about the different types of materials, as well as describing them and thinking about their purposes.

Computing

We will start by finding information, focusing on the use of the internet to research specific information on buildings and places in London.

We will then move on to using email. We will be thinking about how we can contact people through the internet and try writing our very own emails.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

Geography



In geography we will be studying London. We will learn the landmarks of London and locate them on maps of the city. We will think about whether they are a human feature or physical. We will look at aerial maps and begin to use compass directions. We will be thinking about how things have changed over the last 100 years in London.

R.E.



This term Elm class will be studying Islam. We will be thinking about Muslim worship, values and beliefs. We will be thinking about how these relate to our own lives and Christianity.

History



In History we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. We will be learning about how the fire started, how it spread and how it was stopped. We will be looking at what life was like during this period in London and thinking about how we know so much about the fire, by looking at different sources.

D&T



This half term, we will be making our own houses linked to the Great Fire of London. We will be building them using cardboard boxes. We may also get the opportunity to do some baking!

Art



Children in Elm class will be investigating Art through London's buildings this term. We will be paying particular attention to the changing architecture of buildings through time. We will be spending time comparing building designs and patterns and looking at sketches made by famous artists of these buildings.
