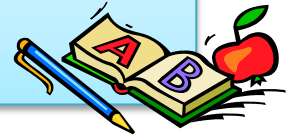




# Nursery News 8

## **This week in Nursery...**

We have been learning about winter and cold weather, especially snow! The children have enjoyed reading and watching the story of The Snowman and doing lots of related activities. We have been talking about the clothes we need to wear in Winter to keep us warm and will be learning about different activities that people can do when the weather is snowy and icy, like skiing and ice-skating.

## **Next week in Nursery...**

We will be starting our new topic, "Traditional Tales". Our first story will be The Gingerbread Man. We will be encouraging the children to join in with telling the story and to act it out. We will be making our own gingerbread and doing some experiments to see what happens when it gets wet. There will be lots of counting the gingerbread man's buttons and activities involving circles.
