## This week...

On Wednesday Kim from Torrington Dental came to teach us about looking after our teeth. We learned all about bacteria on our teeth and how to brush them. The disclosing tablets left the most amazing shades of pink and purple on the children's teeth and tongues which they then had to get rid of using their toothbrushes.

Kim left us with 3 key points to remember:

1. Brush the gum and then the tooth.
2. Spit but don't rinse (rinsing gets rid of the fluoride from the toothpaste which helps protect our teeth)
3. Only eat sugar 4 times a day

This was a great experience for the children - a big thank you to Kim and Torrington Dental.
