

Reception Peek @ the Week

This week...

Following on from our 'What the Ladybird Heard' topic, the children have shown a real interest in learning about farms, including why we have farms and the role they play in our lives. The children have enjoyed discussions about the different products we get from farm animals and the food which grows on farms.

Home Learning...

In Maths we have been learning about shapes; naming common 2d and 3d shapes and talking about their properties (how many corners, faces or edges they have). The children have explored which shapes roll and why some shapes are better for a particular purpose

While you are out and about this weekend see if you can spot shapes in the environment and talk about their purpose. Encourage your child to explain the reasons for their thinking based on what they know about the shapes e.g "I know that a ball is a sphere because spheres have no corners so they can roll."
