This week...

Following on from last week, we have continued sharing traditional tales and fairytales with the children. Each class has been working together to create their own story using picture prompts and actions to help them remember it. Why not ask your child to tell you their story and maybe try making up your own story with your child encouraging them to think of **who, where, what happens, who helps** and **where last**.

Letters and Sounds...

The children have two new Tricky words in their packs: **so** and **said**.

They have been practising reading and writing words containing an additional consonant e.g. melt, sink, tent.



Spring...

Next week we will be focusing on sequencing in Maths, as part of this we will think about days, months and seasons. While you are out and about at the weekend, please could you take time with your child to have a look for signs of Spring and talk to them about the sorts of things that indicate the seasons are changing. You might spot lambs in fields, buds or blossom on trees, daffodils at the road side or hear birds singing in your garden. If your child would like to bring in a picture of something they have noticed they will be able to share it with their class next week.
