Reading...

Now that all of the children have been given reading books they should be changing their books regularly and reading at home on a daily basis. We remind the children to change their books each day so please let us know if your child is forgetting to do this. We will collect in the reading diaries each day so that we can see how often the children are reading and read any comments written in them. The children will get a sticker if they have read at home and if a child has read 5 times in a week their name will appear on the Reception newsletter. Regular reading at home will make the most difference to your child learning to read so we really hope you will support us (and them) with this.

Outdoor Learning...

Forest School sessions will begin again next week, they will take place on Friday afternoons. We are expecting the weather to remain cold so the children need to bring: long trousers, a long-sleeved t-shirt, 2 jumpers, leggings or pyjama bottoms (to wear under trousers), hats and gloves, thick socks, waterproofs and wellies.

Snack...

Just a reminder that all children should bring a named fruit snack to school each day. They may also bring a small carbohydrate snack such as bread sticks or crackers. Remember drinks bottles should contain water, not juice or squash.
