This week...

We have continued to focus on the book 'Mr Big', the children have sequenced the events in the story and created their own story maps to help them retell the story.

The weather has also caused lots of excitement in Reception this week; we have talked about the difference between rain, sleet, snow, frost and hail. It's lovely for the children to experience this kind of thing first hand and to be able to understand how cold ice is and how quickly it melts. It has promoted lots of new language and good questioning skills.

Letters and Sounds...

This week we have introduced the sounds **short oo** and **long oo, ar, or** and tricky word **my**. The children have been using these sounds in their reading and writing. Please keep practising the sounds and words in the packs.
