- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers when teaching PE
- supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs
- paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools.

Curriculum	<p>Class teachers teach use the 'REAL PE' program to develop pupils Fundamental Movement Skills (FMS) – agility, balance and coordination. The sessions also foster a positive attitude to sport, provide regular opportunities for healthy competition and enhance essential life skills. Teaching staff have all received 2-3 Days of high quality CPD in PE (13-14) this year lead by Phil Wylie of Create Development.</p> <p>Dance and gymnastics are also taught by class teachers either as part of REAL PE or discretely. Outdoor skills such as orienteering, climbing, caving and team activities are developed during residential visits in both Y4 and Y6.</p> <p>In 14-15 All new teaching staff will receive training in REAL PE to ensure consistently high quality T&L in PE.</p>	
Curriculum (teacher release time)	<p>KS1 In KS1 pupils further develop REAL PE during PE sessions.</p>	<p>KS2 We employ specialist coaches to teach in KS2 for one session per class per week. Learning focuses on the traditional 'games' such as football, cricket, hockey, netball, tennis, rugby etc. In addition pupils develop athletic skills and all round fitness.</p>
Competition	<p>Currently we attend a minimum of 12 festivals/ tournaments per year, which involves participation and competition alongside other local schools. Our competitions include matches against local schools (state and public) or half day events hosted usually at a Secondary School, where we perform against other Bristol schools. These include cross country, 'games', gymnastics, tri golf among other sports.</p> <p>We annually take part in the 'Stages' dance festival and the gymnastic festival.</p> <p>Most PE session include an element of healthy competition. In addition we hold an annual Sports Day where our house teams compete against one another. Sports week in 14-15 will focus on promoting new or alternative sports to encourage even more pupils to becoming involved in physical activity.</p> <p>In 14-15 we are increasing tournaments/ competition in KS2 at lunchtimes, KS1 in lesson times and during sports week.</p>	
School links	<p>We work with local schools to improve opportunities to participate in sports, via the Wesport (Area) website or through 'cluster events.</p> <p>Recently we have developed a strong link with RGS school, who are to host three annual sporting events for our pupils to attend every year in KS2. Such events will also include coaching by their Y10/11 sports leaders.</p>

Outreach	We seek the best possible provision in PE for our learners. Last year our KS2 staff and pupils (and this year EYFS and KS1 pupils) have received specialist PE teaching via the Bristol School of Gymnastics. We will continue to seek outreach support as and when required.	
After School Clubs	Currently we offer between 2 to 4 sporting activities per night after school for pupils to undertake. We have worked hard to ensure a range of sports are provided, at both our Worrall Road and Lower Redland Road site. Both external providers and school staff lead each club. We are constantly seeking views from parents and pupils on how to engage more pupils into sport.	
Pupil activities	<p>Junior Leaders We have 20 pupils in Y5 trained with the skills to lead sporting sessions for other children during lunchtimes. Currently our Junior leaders lead activities for Y3/4 for 3 lunchtimes per week, which are providing very popular. (New leaders in be trained in Term 5 14-15)</p>	<p>Health and Well Being Change 4 Life Club (KS2) School staff run this club focused on increasing physical activity and promoting healthy lifestyles in pupils and families requires support.</p> <p>Family FUNS (KS1). As above with a KS1 focus.</p>
Active Travelling	In addition to PE we encourage our children to develop healthy and sustainable habitats in travelling to school. We hold a weekly active Wednesday to continually promote active travel. In addition, we have taken part in the Big Pedal fortnight and the 20 mph campaign. Our pupils in Y4 and Y6 are given the opportunity to take part in both Level 1 and 2 Bike Ability sessions. We received £3k from Sustrans to improve our scooter and bike storage on site.	
Facilities	In 14-15 we have increased the number of pitches available from 1 to 2 for pupils to take part in physical activity. This doubles amount of lunchtime sport and after school clubs possible within the site. The pitches will allow PE lessons to continue to operate effectively through school expansion. In addition a trim trail and target practice area has increase the amount of physical activity at lunchtime.
