## KS2 Swimming – Summer Term 2019

We will be starting our swimming lessons for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 on **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April** (excluding 16/5/19 - SATs week) at Polkyth Leisure Centre in St Austell for 11 weeks, the last session is **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July**. We will be leaving school at 9.50 am and return in time for lunchtime.

Children will need a swimming costume and towel clearly named. They will also need to have a coat, as it can be very cold when they get out of the water. Please ensure children's bags, clothes and swimming equipment have their names on. This makes it a lot easier for children to get dressed at the end of the swimming session. Please do not give children talcum powder or deodorant to use as the swimming pool does not allow children to use these items.

Children who wear earrings will need their jewellery removed on the morning of swimming as they will not be able to wear it in the pool and it also saves it from being lost if the children have to take it out themselves.

Children who use inhalers will be required to carry them in their bags and use them if necessary. If your child has any other medical issues could you please let the class teacher know as soon as possible. It is very important for us to know your child's level of experience in the water. Could you please indicate their swimming level on the form below.

The cost of each session will be £3.50 and all children will be required to attend each session. Children will not be able to stay behind at school with another class as swimming is a national requirement in the primary curriculum. If your child is not well enough to swim, they are not well enough to be in school. You can pay each week or for the whole 11 sessions at once using our online payment service Parentpay.

If you have any questions regarding swimming please do not hesitate to ask your child's class teacher.
