

# Over the hills and far away...

This term we will be looking at different story books. We will be talking about our favourite story book characters and learning about the places where they live.

In **Literacy** we will be retelling fairy tales and learning about stories with different settings. We will be writing a class poetry book.

In **Science** we will be finding out about animals and their habitats. We will also be looking at the seasons and weather. We will be naming parts of our body.

In **Art** we will be using a variety of media to create pictures and collages of different story book characters.

In **PSHE** we will be learning about ourselves and relationships and valuing differences. We will be talking about how to be a good friend and working together.

In **Maths** we will be reading, writing and ordering numbers to 20 and identifying one more and one less than a number. We will begin to use correct mathematical language for explaining calculations. We will be using addition and subtraction to calculate answers and solve real life problems. We will be learning more about shapes.



In **ICT** we will be developing our keyboard skills and learning how to access a range of programs. We will be using interactive resources to find out more about castles.

In **Design and Technology** we will be designing a home for the 'Hungry Caterpillar'. We will be making dens during our Forest School sessions. We will be looking at healthy and varied diets.

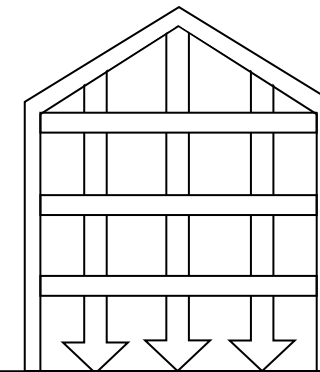
# Year One Topic Overview Autumn 2018
