**Monday 6th July** - Work starts in Nursery Garden (For approx. 3 days)

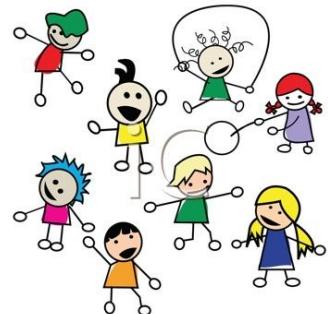
**Wednesday 15th July** - Sports Day at Itter Park
