Use the rhymes to help you with your joined up handwriting.

Start on the line...



<i>m</i>	...in, Maisey, mountain, mountain, flick
<i>a</i>	...in, round the apple, down the leaf, flick
<i>s</i>	...in, slither down the snake, out
<i>d</i>	...in, round his bottom, up his tall neck, down to his feet, flick
<i>t</i>	...in, down the tower, across the tower
<i>i</i>	...in, down the body, flick, dot for the head
<i>n</i>	...in, down Nobby and over his net, flick
<i>p</i>	...in, down the plait and over the pirate's face, out
<i>g</i>	...in, round her face, down her hair and give her a curl, out
<i>o</i>	...in, all around the orange, out
<i>c</i>	...in, curl around the caterpillar
<i>k</i>	...in, down the kangaroo's body, up round and down, flick
<i>u</i>	...in, down and under, up to the top and out, flick

<i>b</i>	...in, down the laces to the heel, round the toe, out
<i>f</i>	...in, down the stem and draw the leaves, out
<i>e</i>	...in, lift off the top and scoop the egg
<i>l</i>	...in, down the long leg, flick
<i>h</i>	...in, down the head to the horse's hooves and over his back, flick
<i>sh</i>	...in, slither down the snake and down the head to the horse's hooves and over his back, flick
<i>r</i>	...in, down his back, then curl over his arm
<i>j</i>	...in, down his body, curl and dot, out
<i>v</i>	...in, down a wing, up a wing, out
<i>y</i>	...in, down a horn, up a horn and under his head, out
<i>w</i>	...in, down, up, down, up, out
<i>th</i>	...in, down the tower and down the horse's head to the hooves and over his back, flick. Then, across the tower
<i>z</i>	...in, zig-zag-zig
<i>ch</i>	...in, curl round the caterpillar and go down the horse's head to the hooves and over his back, flick
<i>qu</i>	...in, round her head, up past her earrings and down her hair and down and under, up to the top and flick
<i>x</i>	...in, down the arm and leg and repeat the other side, out
