School improvement:

We have been working with South Farnham Schools (Infants and Juniors) in order to drive through improvements. This includes teaching staff from Broadmere visiting and observing teaching and learning at the South Farnham Schools as well as a leadership partner from South Farnham Trust working with the leadership team at Broadmere and New Monument schools to quality assure judgements of teaching and learning.
