Punctuality:

Nursery:



We have been very busy this half term, getting settled into the new hours of the setting. These changes have been very positive and the children have been enjoying lots of extended learning over a whole day. The children have made vegetable soup this term which they enjoyed tasting in the afternoon. They have participated in sensory fun outside as well having happy, calm lunchtimes with their friends. The children



are also enjoying small group times with their key workers and we have been exploring the story of 'Stickman' as well as 'Oliver's Vegetables' for the Harvest theme. Our children love to sing and have learned some new songs – ask them to sing to you at home.



Year 5:

Year 5 have been Stargazers this half term! We haven't been into space yet, but we have carried out extensive research! We know data about all of the planets; we have investigated orbits, why we have day and night, as well as learning about the moon and its phases. We have found out about significant scientists, particularly Galileo, Galilei and Sir Isaac Newton, and considered their impact on our scientific thinking. We have been generating effective vocabulary in English in order to respond to the atmospheric clip, I Live On The Moon. However, it has been our poetry writing that has taken us up to space and beyond as we have written Countdown Poems and Zero-gravity Free Verse!

Sports events:

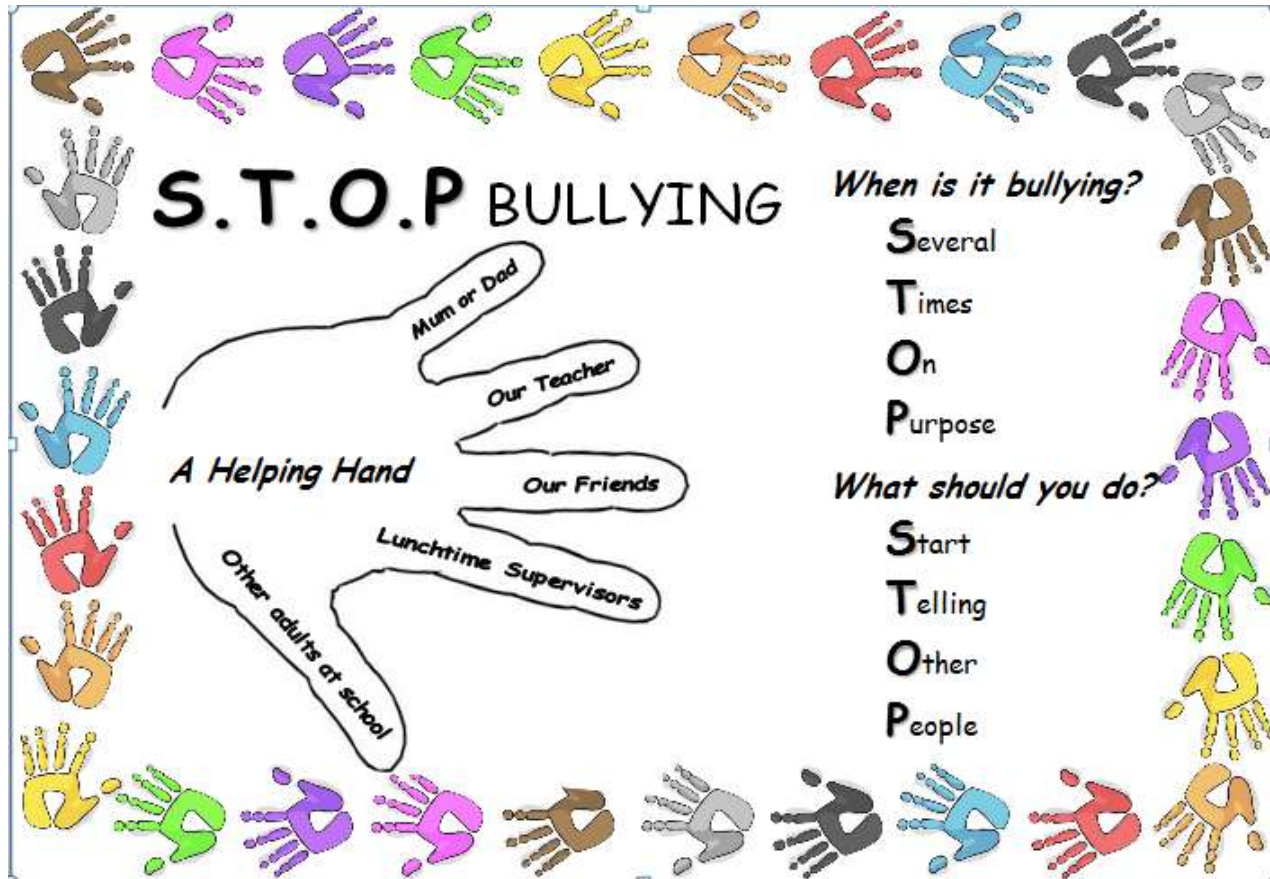
Broadmere have already competed in their first competition of the year, which was a year 5 and 6 girl's football tournament. They played 3 matches, lost two against very strong oppositions and won one. The girls played very well considering that it was their first competition together and spirits were high. The year 5 and 6 boys participated in their first competition on Friday, 13th October. On the Thursday 5th of October, ten year 5 students represented Broadmere at a year 5 and 6 Sports Crew leaders training. These children will now be able to run lunch time clubs for other children within the school. They also received certificates for their hard work that morning which they thoroughly enjoyed.

After school clubs - keeping our children fit and healthy:

Year 2 children have participated in our after school clubs which are football on a Monday and multi-sports on a Tuesday. These are run by Mr Garvey. Years 3 and 4 have multi-sports on Monday and football on the Tuesday. Years 5 and 6 have fitness club on a Wednesday, football on a Thursday and multi-sports on a Friday. These are run by Mr Dore.

As a school committed to inspiring our children to uphold global and British values, we intervene as soon as a problem, real or perceived, is brought to our attention. We aim to help the children to differentiate between bullying and 'falling out' with a friend or struggling to understand when a peer is unwilling to comply with the wishes of another.
