Year 11 have been doing there exams this week and Mrs Walsh proudly said "They have been studying hard and concentrating well in there English, Maths and ICT exams".

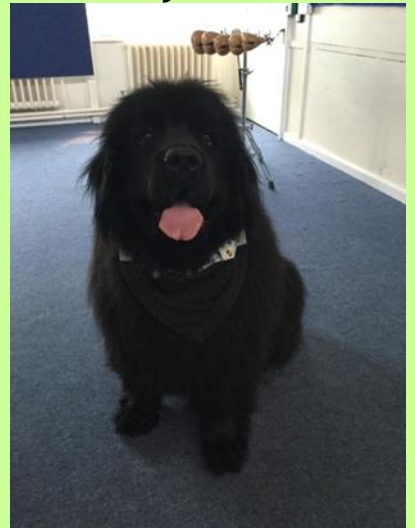
