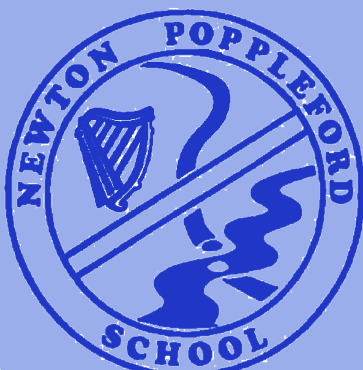

Parking on double yellow lines

After the unfortunate accident last year, parking outside the school improved beyond all recognition. Children were able to cross the road in relative safety .

With the building work, it is even more important that children can feel safe coming out of the temporary school entrance. Some parents have expressed concerns about the potential congestion by this entrance. Parking on the double yellow lines opposite the temporary school entrance adds to this congestion and puts children and adult's safety at risk.

Car parking spaces in the immediate vicinity of the school have not decreased so there is no excuse to illegally park on the double yellow lines. Last school year we had visits from Devon Highways and the police to enforce the parking regulations.

Each week the club makes some aspect of creative craft. So far this term they have created Minions bookmarks and Button trees. Unfortunately, Craft Club is full up this term.





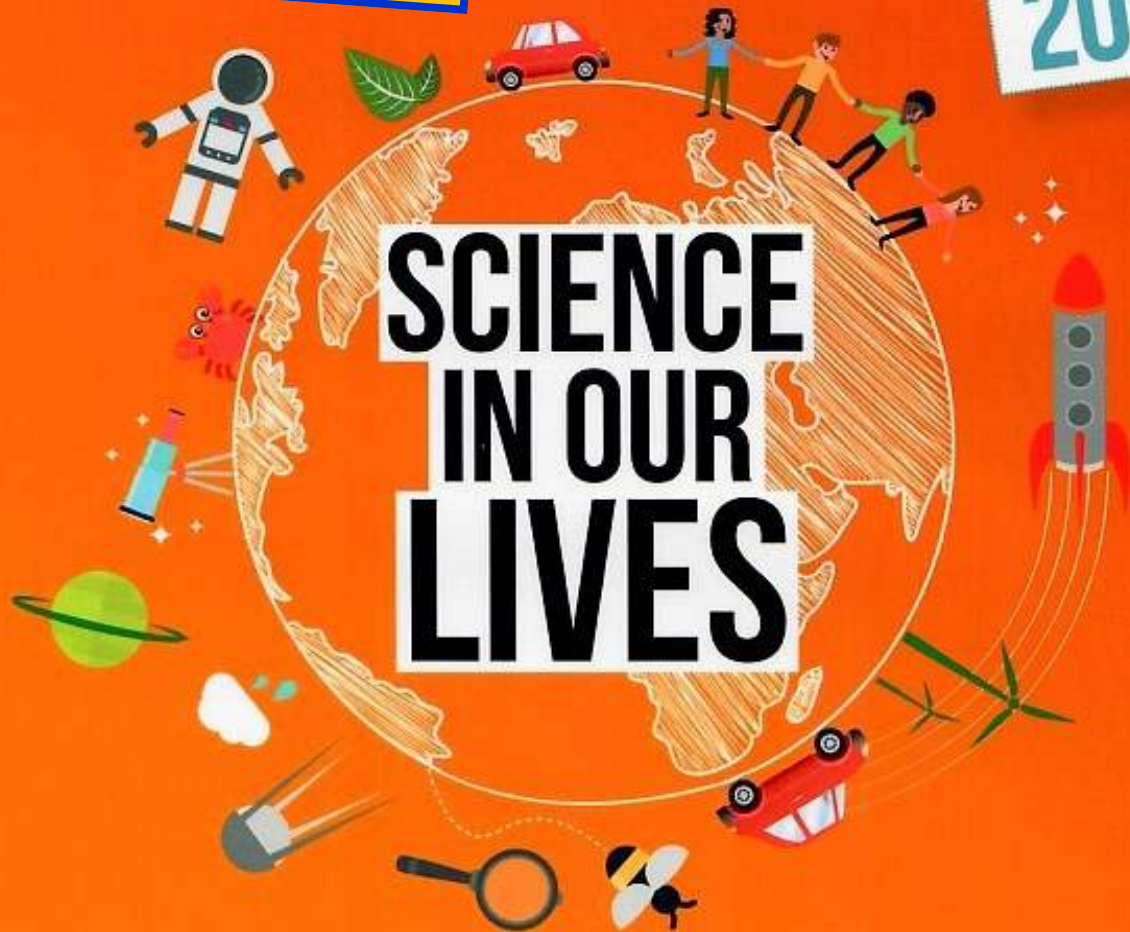
