about:-

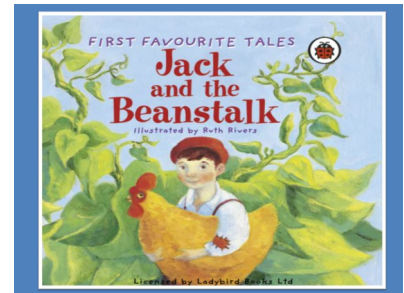


JACK AND THE BEAN- STALK
