As with those run during previous school holidays, the days will be led by Mr Brown and Mr Bardot (Whimple CC cricket coach and PE teacher to primary schools).

From 9.00am to 3.00pm, we will split our time between inside and outside sporting activities, with a few brain games too! In addition to specific skills and techniques, sessions will cover the basics of agility, balance, co-ordination, speed, and spatial awareness using a variety of sports but most of all focusing on FUN!
