From Tuesday 22nd January we will be launching a free breakfast service for Mount Street pupils, funded by the National school breakfast programme which is funded by the Department for Education and delivered by two charities: Family Action and Magic breakfast. Bagels will be available from the hall cooking area between 8:30-8:45. This is in addition to our existing 'before school club' where you can access childcare and a breakfast from 8-8:45; the childcare option will continue to be a paid for service. (Costs for this are available from the school office.) For the duration of the Magic breakfast project, breakfasts eaten in the 'before school club' will be free of charge.

Our plan is to provide bagels this week and to extend this to also include cereals and porridge in coming weeks. So, come to the PPA cooking area between 8:30-8:45 from Tuesday onwards and receive a free bagel.
