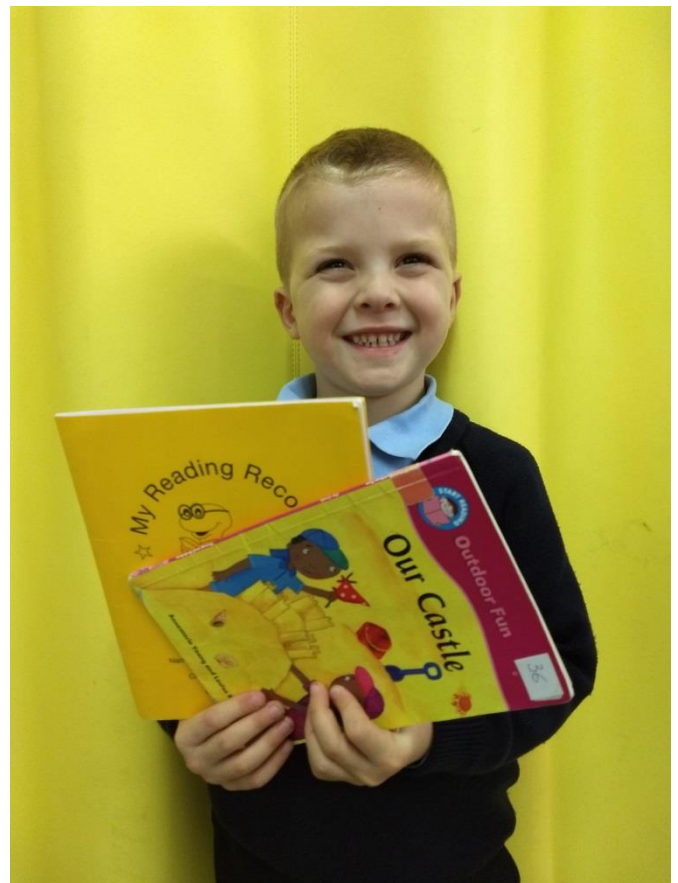

Is your child eligible for Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium Grant is a sum of money from the Government which is given to schools for children who are eligible for free school meals, 'looked after' children who are in the care of someone other than their parents or to the children of service personnel. This sum of money is used in school to provide additional staff to support eligible children in class and in booster groups as well as to support swimming costs and trips. So that your child isn't missing out on the benefits that this additional funding brings, you need to apply – it doesn't come to school unless you have applied for it.
