



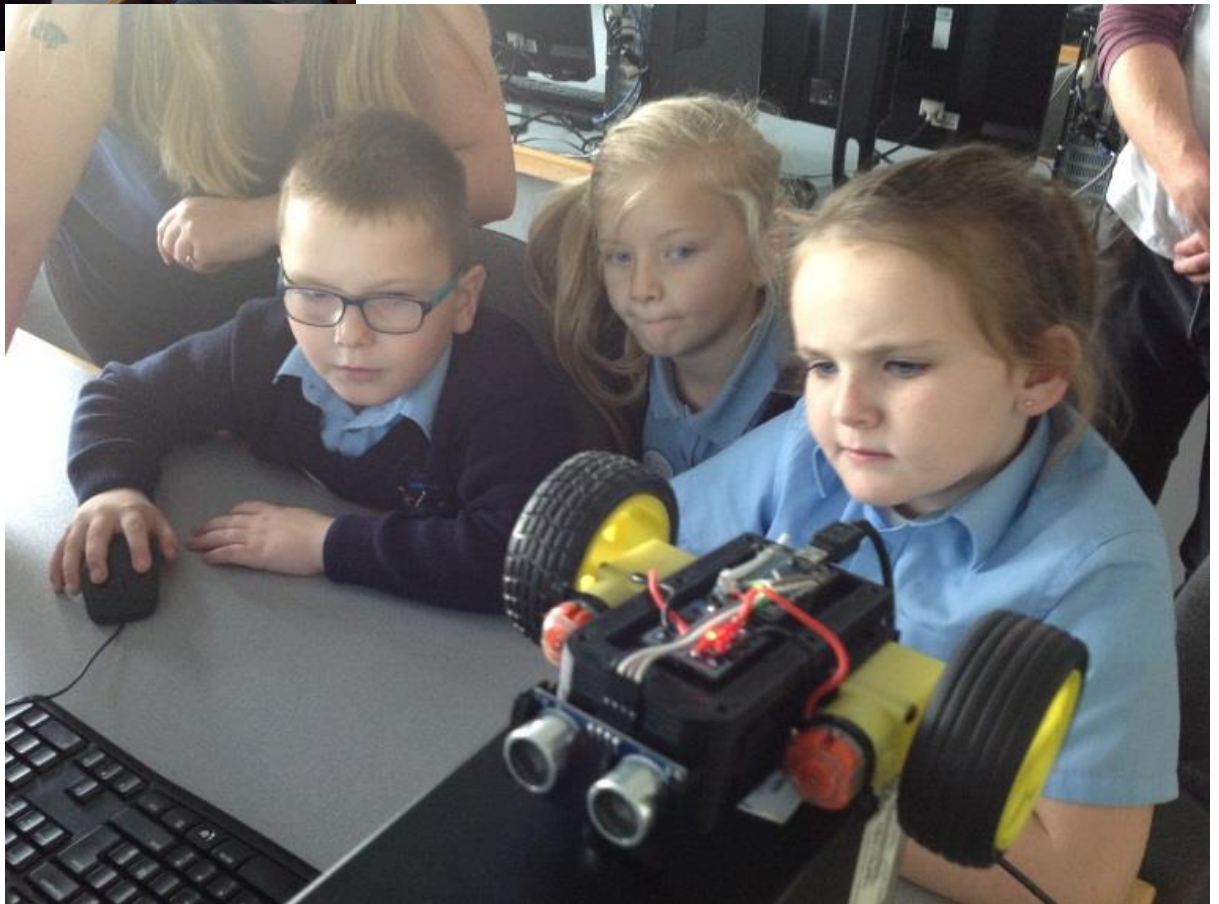
# Mount Street Primary News

representatives of our athletics club have taken part in an athletics competition at Lipson...

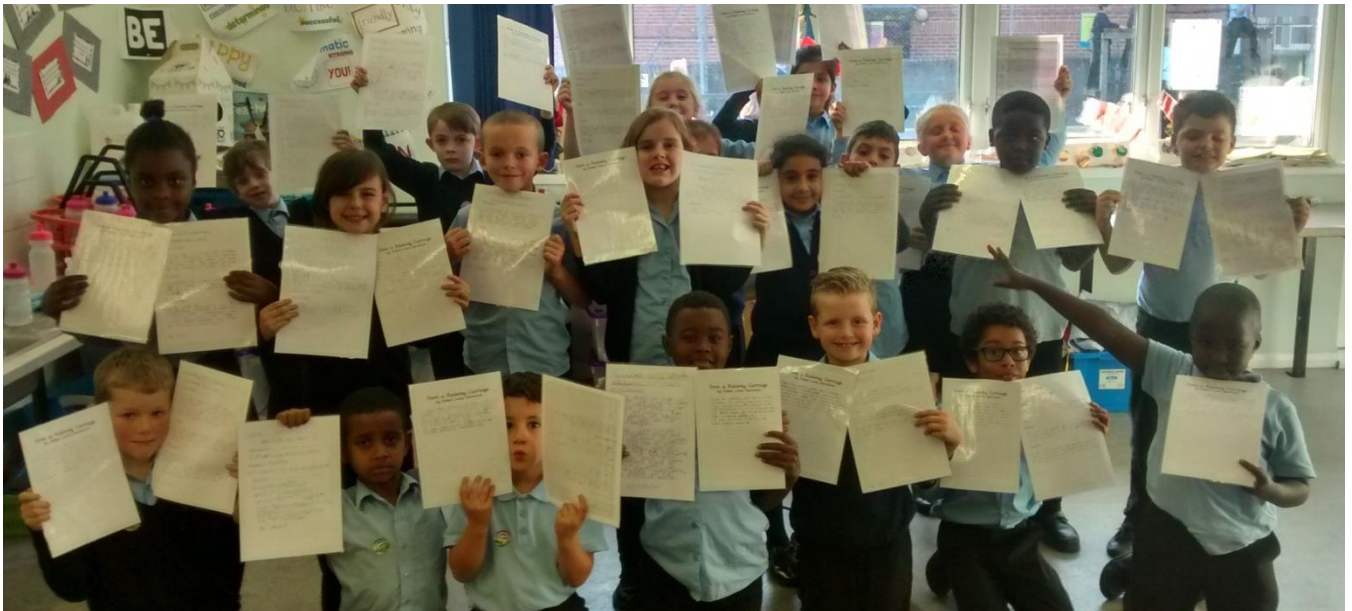


and our cross-country squad received their certificates...
