Congratulations to Taylor in Year 2 who was very proud to bring in his certificate and medal after participating in a rugby festival

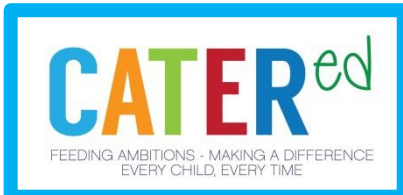
